



### Loki's Wolves




### Pandora Gets Jealous





### The Serpent's Secret


### The Colossus Rises




### Where the Mountain Meets the Moon

by Michael Northrop


From the creators of *The 39 Clues* and *Spirit Animals* series comes a new epic Egyptian adventure that finds the mother of gravely ill Alex Sennefer


